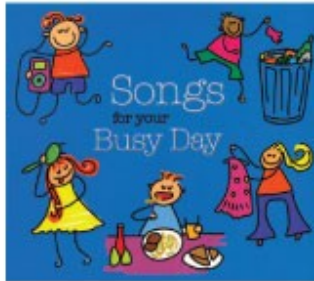


Songs and Words to Inspire
